

Cub Scout Day Camp Parent Information Sheet

Location:

Hawk Mountain Scout Reservation is an official Boy Scout Camp nestled in the woods in Schuylkill County. It is located just about a mile and a half off of Route 183. From the south, you must travel over the Blue Mountain. Turn left right past the Blue Ridge Hotel onto Blue Mountain Road and look for the camp sign on your left.. Traveling from the north, you must turn right onto Blue Mountain Road and the sign for the camp will be on the left as well.

Cost:

The cost for Day Camp is \$100.00. This cost covers all program materials, insurance, and beverages during the meal. The fees should be handled by your Pack's camp coordinator.

Here is the time table your pack will follow:

\$10.00 per boy deposit due by March 1

\$90.00 final payment by June 1

\$10.00 late fee will be applied if paid at camp

Camperships are available through Council. **No boy should miss out on camp because of Money Issues.** Talk to your Pack's camp coordinator about the specifics.

Medicals:

All Cub Scouts, adults, and family members planning to come to Day Camp must complete a medical history form. The form does not require a doctor's signature, but does require a parent to sign. Any boy without a signed form will not be allowed to participate.

Transportation:

Transportation arrangements should be made through the Pack's camp coordinator. This person may need your help to transport boys to and/or from camp. Please be prepared to help.

Leadership

We ask that each pack have at least one adult per den. To maintain control of the group, it is recommended more adults accompany a den. Adults play a very significant role in day camp because of the need for extra help in program areas. This leads to less frustration for the boys and makes participation and learning more enjoyable for all.

Please plan to attend with your Cub Scout and make memories that will last a life time.

Lunch:

Camp will provide a hot lunch for each Cub Scout every day. The cost is included in the camp fee. Siblings and adults may purchase lunch each day for \$5.00 or buy a meal ticket for all five days for \$20.00.

Equipment and Gear:

Clothing suited to weather

Bathing suit and towel

No sandals or flip flops

Hat

Water Bottle

Rain gear (**camp goes on rain or shine**)

Small backpack

Do not send walkmans or hand held video games

Trading post:

There is a trading post which sells souvenirs, snacks, and some camping supplies.

Absences and Early Departures:

Any boy that is absent or is a no show at camp must be verified through the Pack Leadership. You may receive a phone call from the Camp Director if the pack leader is unable to verify an absence.

Boys will only be released to their parents or guardians. In the case of an early dismissal, written permission must be obtained in order to release to another person.

Anyone reporting in late or leaving early must do so in the Cub Administration Office.
